WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT:

- 1. NOTIFY THE POLICE.** Arizona law requires that if you are the driver of a vehicle involved in an injury accident, the police must be given prompt notice.
- 2. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.** You are required to render "reasonable assistance" to anyone who has been injured in the accident. If you think you may have been injured, you should not refuse medical assistance at the scene. If you experience any medical complaints after leaving the scene, do not delay in seeking treatment.
- 3. WITNESSES.** To the extent possible, obtain the name, address and telephone number of any witness to your accident.
- 4. INFORMATION EXCHANGE.** Exchange your name, address and insurance information with the other driver.
- 5. CONVERSATIONS WITH THE OTHER DRIVER.** It is better not to discuss the details of the accident with the other driver. If the other driver should admit fault, be sure to make a note of what is said.
- 6. PRESERVE THE EVIDENCE.** Do not discard, repair or change anything involved in the accident until you know your legal rights.
- 7. DEALING WITH THE OTHER PARTY'S INSURANCE COMPANY.** You should not give any statements or sign anything for the other party's insurance company until you know your legal rights.
- 8. LEGAL ASSISTANCE.** If you have been injured in an accident, you may need a personal injury lawyer. Not knowing your legal rights may be very costly.
